St. Luke's to Offer Adult Immunizations to Community

Boise – Treasure Valley residents in need of adult immunizations can now receive them through St. Luke's Occupational Health Services.

The decision to add adult immunization services follows last month's announcement by the Central District Health Department that it was discontinuing both its adult and travel vaccine services.

St. Luke's had previously offered travel vaccines and agreed to expand its travel vaccine program following Central District Health's announcement.

To meet the increased demand for travel vaccinations, St. Luke's added additional staff and streamlined its processes.

"Now that our infrastructure is in place, we're pleased to be able to add the adult immunizations," said Brian VandenDries, manager of St. Luke's Occupational Health Services. "With Central District Health no longer an option, we expect an increased demand for these services."

Twenty different vaccines will be available for administration by appointment only at St. Luke's Occupational Health, 703 American Blvd., No. 103, between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

The vaccinations will be provided only to adults, on a cash-payment basis. Vaccinations will not be provided to immigrants or refugees, as those groups will continue to receive vaccinations through Central District Health.

St. Luke's will verify all vaccination records and all records will be kept on site. If follow-up care is needed St. Luke's has a physician referral service available.
