Founded in 1956 as McCall Memorial Hospital, the medical center and clinics integrated with St. Luke's Health System in 2010. In 2023, we opened an expanded, modernized hospital and a new urgent care in the community. Our local network includes clinics in McCall, New Meadows and Riggins.
